

What you CAN recycle

Cardboard boxes & packaging

- cardboard (including corrugated cardboard)
- cereal boxes and egg cartons
- removalist boxes
- tissue boxes (plastic slip removed) and toilet rolls
- pizza box (empty with minimal oil)
- shredded paper (ONLY within a paper bag)

Firm plastic containers & bottles (all lids and caps smaller than a credit card must be disposed of in rubbish)

- milk, juice, cordial bottles (with lid)
- shampoo and conditioner bottles
- soft drink bottles
- Ice cream containers
- yogurt and other dairy tubs
- fruit punnet containers
- seedling containers
- plastic storage containers with a plastic code of 1, 2 and 5.
- takeaway containers with a plastic code 1, 2 and 5.
- biscuit and meat trays
- plant pots
- lunch boxes (codes 1, 2 & 5)
- medicine bottles (glass or plastic)
- Tupperware containers

Paper

- glossy magazines
- junk mail and brochures
- newspapers
- paper (used or new)
- paper bags
- wrapping and packaging paper
- letters without clear window
- books (covers removed)

Aluminium

- aluminium foil, including trays (remove food scraps and scrunch foil into a ball.)
- food cans
- soft drink cans
- aerosol cans (Empty)
- aluminium bottles (empty with lid)
- beer bottle caps and jar lids
- blister packs (aluminium)
- Empty paint tins

Glass bottles & jars

(all lids and caps smaller than a credit card must be disposed of in rubbish)

- beer, wine and spirits bottles
- beverage bottles
- jam jars
- sauce bottles and jars
- broken glass (bottles and jars)
