Paper

- envelopes (including window envelopes)
- glossy magazines
- greeting cards
- junk mail and brochures
- newspapers
- notepaper and scrap paper
- office paper (white and coloured)
- paper bags
- phone books
- wrapping and packaging paper

Steel and aluminium

- aerosol cans (empty)
- aluminium foil, including pie trays
- food cans (aluminium or steel)
- soft drink cans
- jar lids
- formula tins
- insect spray bottles and cans

Glass bottles and jars

- beer, wine and spirits bottles
- beverage bottles
- jam jars
- sauce bottles and jars

Cardboard boxes and packaging

- cardboard (including corrugated cardboard)
- cereal boxes and egg cartons
- manilla folders
- pizza boxes (no waxed or greasy cardboard
- removal boxes
- tissue boxes and toilet rolls

Firm plastic containers and bottles

- biscuit, sushi trays
- margarine containers
- milk, juice, cordial bottles
- shampoo and conditioner bottles
- soft drink bottles (air squeezed out and replace the cap)
- fruit punnet containers
- takeaway containers (plastic codes 1, 2, and 5)
- yoghurt and ice cream tubs
- plastic cutlery
- detergent bottles
- deodorant cans, roll-ons and sprays (remove ball from roll-on)
- disposable coffee cup lids only
- plant pots
