Paper

- envelopes (including window envelopes)
- glossy magazines
- greeting cards
- junk mail and brochures
- newspapers
- notepaper and scrap paper
- office paper (white and coloured)
- paper bags
- wrapping and packaging paper

Steel and aluminium

- aerosol cans (empty)
- aluminium foil (scrunch up into a tennis size ball)
- food cans (aluminium or steel)
- soft drink cans
- formula tins

Glass bottles and jars

- beer, wine and spirits bottles
- beverage bottles
- jam jars (leave the lid and label on)
- sauce bottles and jars (leave the lid and label on)

Cardboard boxes and packaging

- cardboard (including corrugated cardboard)
- cereal boxes and egg cartons
- pizza boxes (no food scraps)
- removal boxes (flattened)
- tissue boxes and toilet rolls

Firm plastic containers and bottles

- biscuit, sushi trays
- margarine containers
- milk, juice, cordial bottles
- shampoo and conditioner bottles
- soft drink bottles (leave the lid and labels on)
- fruit punnet containers
- takeaway containers (plastic codes 1, 2, and 5)
- yoghurt and ice cream tubs (plastic tubs only)
- detergent bottles
- none-polystyrene meat trays
- biscuit trays
